

For Sceen Top Enclosures and Terrariums



- 1. (Reptile One ONLY) Remove the complete cable entry dial assembly on your Reptile One Enclosure. The locking ring and Cable Dial are not required for this assembly. (Diagram A)
- 2. Carefully make a hole in your mesh enclosure lid around 70mm dia. (Refer to template on back of page)
- 3. Unscrew the end cap on the ceramic socket.
- 4. Then carefully unscrew the ceramic socket around **5 mm** opening **(2 Turns)**.


Locking ring Cable Dial ring




5. (Reflector ONLY) Feed the Reflector power cable and socket through frame lid.

- 6. (Reflector ONLY) Use a strong pair of scissors cut the C-ring in half.
- 7. Place the C-Ring around the bottom of the screw thread, then tighten the ceramic socket and end cap.



For Wooden Top Enclosures and Terrariums



Instruction version: 19/07/2016

- 1. Carefully make a hole in your Wooden enclosure lid around 70mm dia. (Refer to template below)
- 2. Secure the Cage frame lid to the enclosure using the screws provided.



- 3. Unscrew the end cap on the ceramic socket.
- 4. Then carefully unscrew the ceramic socket around **5 mm** opening **(2 Turns)**.



- 6. (Reflector ONLY) Use a strong pair of scissors cut the C-ring in half.
- 7. Place the C-Ring around the bottom of the screw thread, then tighten the ceramic socket and end cap.

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
